## SBMA Young ARTIST of the MONTH

Sponsored by the South Bend Museum of Art

- Who:** 7<sup>th</sup>- 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in the Michiana region, as well as undergraduate students attending schools in Michiana, who have been recognized by a teacher (art or general education) as demonstrating both a special commitment to and/or proficiency in the visual arts as well as a commitment to his/her community.
- What:** The South Bend Museum of Art will solicit nominations of these students from teachers and will choose from them the students to be featured on the education blog of the SBMA website. These features will include a brief interview of the artist and a gallery of images of his/her work. “Artist of the Month” students will receive a **free studio art class** from SBMA.
- Why:** The recognition of young, local artists is an extension of SBMA’s mission to “affirm the enduring power of the visual arts to reflect and create community” and to “nurture growth.” In promoting the success and talents of these artists, SBMA hopes they will see the SBMA and our community as supportive, inspirational resources for their creative work.
- How:** Local art teachers will receive nomination forms from the SBMA education department and/or download the form from the SBMA website. Nominations will be considered on a rolling basis, and the SBMA education department will notify winning students and their teachers of their selection by telephone.
